The City Council met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom/audio conference technology due to COVID-19 restrictions currently in place.

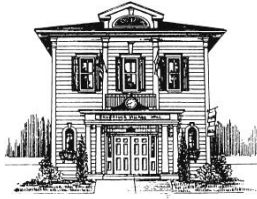

DESCRIPTION

PUBLIC NOTICE

City of Saugatuck Downtown 3-Hour Parking Enforcement

Business owners in the Saugatuck downtown business district have voiced concerns the 3-hour parking limit is being abused; thus preventing potential customers and visitors from finding parking for shopping. The City of Saugatuck has requested its law enforcement agency to enforce the 3-hour parking per City Ordinance 70.09 in the general downtown business district on a complaint basis. Individuals that have specific complaints regarding 3-hour time limit violations are instructed to call 269-673-3899 and report the specific location and vehicle. A Saugatuck City Sheriff Deputy will investigate. If the Deputy can confirm a vehicle is in violation of the 3-hour limit, a \$25 parking citation will be issued per City Ordinance.

ORDINANCE 70.09 TIME ZONES

Parking on both sides of Butler Street between the Kalamazoo River on the south end to Main Street on the north end; and both sides of Culver Street from Butler Street on the west end to 350 feet east of Griffith Street on the east end shall be restricted to 3-hour parking.
